

Presidio La Bahia Award

The Presidio La Bahia Award, administered by The Sons of the Republic of Texas is an annual honor recognizing excellence in research, writing, and preservation of Texas's Spanish Colonial heritage. Established by Kathryn Stoner O'Connor, it rewards works highlighting the influence of this period on Texas culture.

Key Details of the Award

- **Purpose:** To promote the preservation of relics and dissemination of data regarding the Spanish Colonial period in Texas.
- **Focus Areas:** Research on Spanish influence in Texas laws, customs, religion, architecture, and art.
- **Eligibility:** Open to any person or group contributing to the understanding of this history.
- **Submission Period:** Entries are accepted annually from June 1 through September 30.
- **Presentation:** Awards are presented annually on the first weekend of December in the Chapel of Our Lady of Loreto at Presidio La Bahia in Goliad.
